The penalty for not having health insurance coverage is going up.



If you choose not to buy health insurance this year, you may need to pay a tax penalty of \$695 or more.



No one plans to get sick or hurt – but it happens. Protect yourself against unexpected medical expenses.

Still need health coverage? Find out if you qualify.

You may have options to get health coverage through a Special Enrollment Period.

What is it?

A Special Enrollment Period is a period of time when individuals and their families are allowed to enroll in a health plan outside of the Open Enrollment Period because of a qualifying life event.



26TH BIRTHDAY

If you're on your parent's plan and you're turning 26



MARRIAGE

If you're saying "I do"



BABY OR ADOPTION

If you're having a baby or your family is growing



NEW ADDRESS

If you're opening the door to a new home



JOB CHANGE

If you're in the middle of a job transition

You may qualify for a Special Enrollment Period.

How much time do I have?

You must enroll in a plan within 60 days of the qualifying life event to be eligible for new coverage.



MEDICAID AND CHIP

Anyone eligible can enroll in Medicaid and CHIP all year long.
